From the Commodore

Hello fellow MBYC members,

On April 12th we held a volunteer day to help with landscaping, mulching and some painting. A great turn out and camaraderie with other members while accomplishing a huge amount of visual appeal. This was followed by a BBQ lunch cooked by Jim Turner. Thanks to the staff and all who helped with this project.

May 17-May 23 is National Safe Boating week, a time to review safe boating practices, checking your required Coast Guard safety equipment, expanding your boating knowledge by taking a Boating Safety Course and weather awareness.

June 1st is the first day of hurricane season. Hurricane forecasters have predicted 2025 will be an above average season with 17 Named Storms, 9 Hurricanes with 4 potentially reaching major status. Time to have your hurricane plans ready. Here are some helpful tips:

- A big enemy to dock lines is chafe. Use extra lines to double up your dock lines.*
- Protect all lines from sharp corners exiting your boat with chafe protection*
- Spread the load on the lines and your boat by using lines attached to more cleats*
- Reduce the wind footprint by taking down canvas and clearing the decks as much as possible*
- Ensure your ports are closed, your batteries are charged up and all bilge pumps are working properly*
- Secure your dinghies, ensure they have working bilge pumps if left in the water*
- Secure the lids to your dock box so they don't blow open*
